



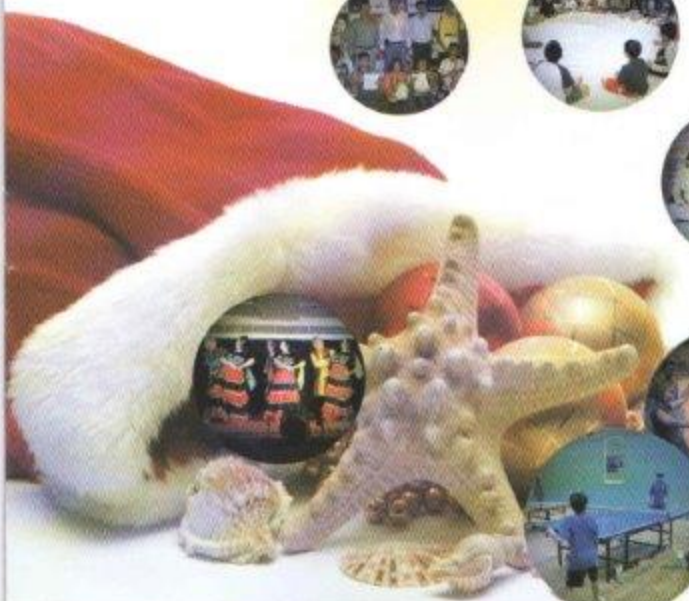
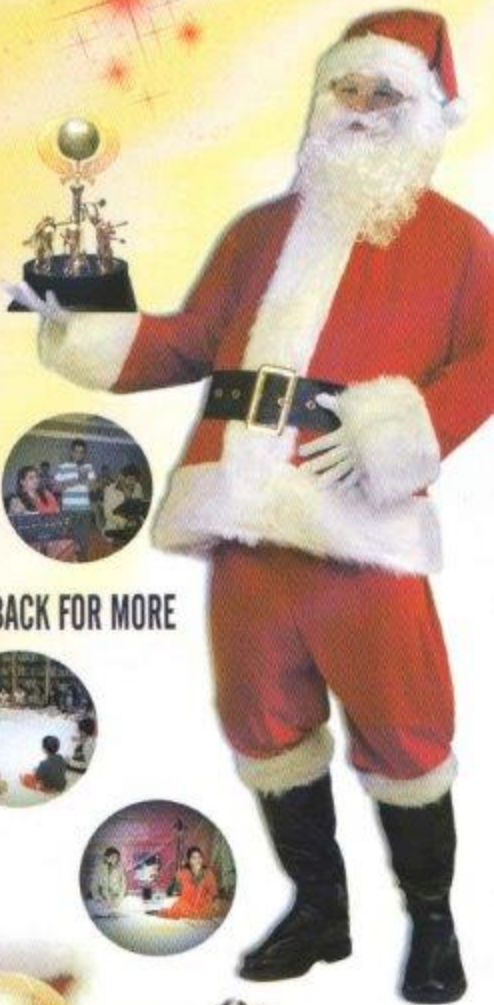

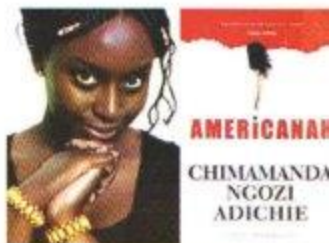

## Book Review - IMAGINATION UNPLUGGED

**T**he book could not have been named anything else. Looking at the world through the eyes of 14-year-old author, Maulik Jain, "Imagination Unplugged", a collection of short stories and personal essays, traverses the realms of innocent yet powerful emotions and observations of a young, hungry, curious yet cautious mind.

The book is actually an unconscious process of unleashing what one has learnt through its simple, lucid, vivid depictions and observations of life in various capacities. Divided into two basic sections of Fiction and Non-Fiction, the book touches a variety of subjects with a subtle aim of evoking and provoking a thought process without getting into mundane details. The multitude of topics swing across emotions and feelings of fear, anger, hatred, hope, despair, happiness, curiosity, love, touching on subjects of fate, philosophy, religion, science, inspiration, dreams, aspirations, technology, global

issues, terror, arts, sports, travel, environment and lifestyles among many others.

The narrative is fresh, bright and descriptive in an unconventional albeit engaging manner, conveying the author's eagerness to test new



waters devoid of the need for acceptance. The honest approach brings forth a credible quotient of maturity for a young teenager and makes for good leisure reading. Many of the topics make one realize the blessing of being born in an era that has witnessed tumultuous changes in every sphere of life in a short span of few decades.

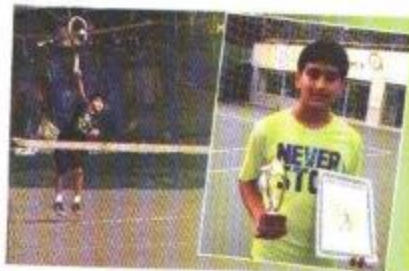

The "Table Tennis Home Tournament 2013" was held after a gap of 5 years on Sunday, 24th November 2013.

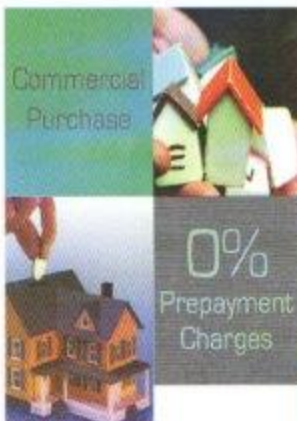

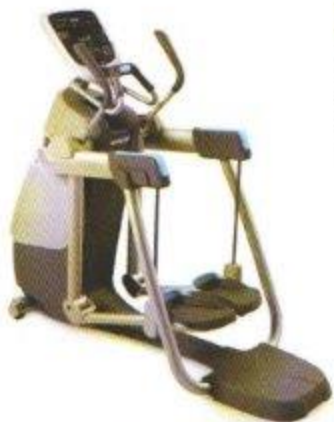

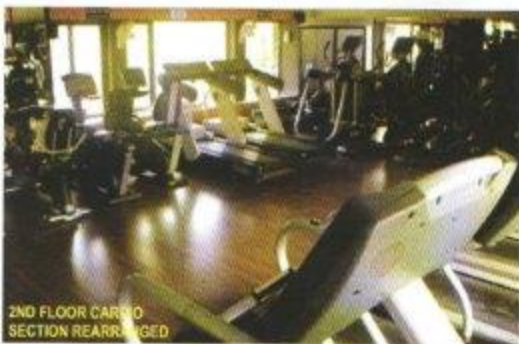
